DAY 1 | FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 3, 2027

Honolulu to Los Angeles or New York

Depart Honolulu and fly to Los Angeles (LAX) or New York (JFK). Upon arrival, transfer to your airport-area hotel for an overnight stay before continuing to Israel.

Meals: On Board | Overnight: Airport-Area Hotel

DAY 2 | SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2027 | Departure for Israel

After your overnight stay, transfer to the airport and board your international flight to Israel. Sit back, relax, and prepare for an unforgettable journey through the Land of the Bible.

Meals: Buffet Dinner | Lodging: On Board

DAY 3 | SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 5, 2027

Arrival in Israel and Visit to Jaffa

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport, where we will be met by our representative, guide, and driver before transferring to Tel Aviv. Check in at the hotel. After dinner, explore historic Jaffa, including St. Peter's Church and beautiful views of the Tel Aviv coastline. Known in the Bible as Joppa, this ancient port was where Jonah boarded a ship while fleeing from the Lord (Jonah 1:3). Centuries later, Peter stayed here with Simon the Tanner and received the vision that prepared the way for the Gospel to be shared with Cornelius and the Gentiles (Acts 9:36-43; Acts 10:9-23).

DAY 4 | MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 6, 2027

Caesarea • Mount Carmel • Megiddo • Nazareth Village and Cana

Travel north along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea, where Peter preached to Cornelius and the Gospel was opened in a remarkable way to the Gentiles (Acts 10:1-48). Caesarea was also where Paul was imprisoned before being sent to Rome (Acts 23:23-35; Acts 25:1-12). Continue to Mount Carmel, where the prophet Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal and called Israel back to the Lord (1 Kings 18:19-39). From there, visit Megiddo, overlooking the Valley of Jezreel and associated with the biblical imagery of Armageddon (Revelation 16:16). Continue to Nazareth, the hometown of Jesus, and visit Nazareth Village, where we will experience a recreation of village life during the time of Christ and gain a deeper understanding of the world in which He grew up (Luke 1:26-38; Luke 4:16-30). We then visit Cana of Galilee, where Jesus performed His first recorded miracle by turning water into wine at a wedding feast (John 2:1-11), before continuing to our hotel on the shores of the Sea of Galilee.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner | Overnight: Sea of Galilee

DAY 5 | TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 7, 2027 | Sea of Galilee and Upper Galilee • Magdala • Mount of Beatitudes • Tabgha • Capernaum • Caesarea Philippi

Explore the heart of Jesus' Galilean ministry, beginning with Magdala, the hometown traditionally associated with Mary Magdalene (Luke 8:1-3). Continue to the Mount of Beatitudes, commemorating Jesus' Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7), and Tabgha, traditionally associated with the feeding of the five thousand (Matthew 14:13-21). Visit Capernaum, which became the center of Jesus' Galilean ministry and where He taught, healed the sick, and performed many miracles (Matthew 4:13; Mark 1:21-34). Continue north to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter declared, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:13-20). Enjoy the beautiful Banias region before returning to the Sea of Galilee.

Days 6 - 8 Tour ITINERARY

DAY 6 | WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2027 | Sea of Galilee, Jordan River and Dead Sea • Sea of Galilee Boat Ride • Jesus Boat • Yardenit Baptismal Site • Beth Shean • Dead Sea

Begin with a memorable boat ride across the Sea of Galilee, recalling the many events that took place on these waters, including Jesus calming the storm and walking on the water (Mark 4:35–41; Matthew 14:22–33). Visit the ancient “Jesus Boat,” a fishing vessel dating to the first century that offers a fascinating glimpse into life around the Sea of Galilee during the time of Jesus. Continue to the Yardenit Baptismal Site on the Jordan River, remembering the baptism of Jesus in the Jordan (Matthew 3:13–17), followed by Beth Shean, where the bodies of Saul and his sons were displayed after their defeat on Mount Gilboa (1 Samuel 31:8–12). Continue south to our wonderful resort on the shores of the Dead Sea. Enjoy free time to relax, float in the famous mineral-rich waters, or experience the hotel’s spa facilities.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner | **Overnight:** Dead Sea

DAY 7 | THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2027 Masada • Ein Gedi • Qumran • Genesis Land and Jerusalem

Ascend Masada by cable car and explore Herod the Great’s remarkable mountaintop fortress overlooking the Dead Sea. Although Masada itself does not play a major role in the biblical narrative, Herod the Great was the ruler of Judea at the time of Jesus’ birth (Matthew 2:1–16). Continue to Ein Gedi, the beautiful desert oasis where David hid from King Saul and famously spared Saul’s life in a cave (1 Samuel 23:29; 1 Samuel 24:1–7). At Qumran, learn about the discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls, including ancient manuscripts of biblical books that have contributed enormously to our understanding of the transmission of Scripture. Continue to Genesis Land for a special biblical experience and lunch in Abraham’s Tent, recalling the hospitality of Abraham and the world of the patriarchs (Genesis 18:1–8). We then ascend through the Judean Hills toward Jerusalem, following a landscape traveled by pilgrims for thousands of years (Psalm 122:1–2).

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch at Genesis Land and Dinner | **Overnight:** Jerusalem

DAY 8 | FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2027 | Old City Jerusalem Mount of Olives • Garden of Gethsemane • Western Wall • Southern Steps • Jewish Quarter • Mount Zion • Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu

Begin at the Mount of Olives with a breathtaking panoramic view of Jerusalem. Walk down the traditional Palm Sunday Road, recalling Jesus’ triumphal entry into Jerusalem (Luke 19:28–44), and stop at Dominus Flevit, commemorating where Jesus wept over the city (Luke 19:41–44). Continue to the Garden of Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed on the night of His betrayal and arrest (Matthew 26:36–46). We then explore Jerusalem’s biblical treasures, including the Temple Mount area, Western Wall, Southern Steps, and historic Jewish Quarter, recalling the Temple’s central role in the life and ministry of Jesus (Luke 2:41–49; John 2:13–22). Continue to Mount Zion to visit the traditional Room of the Last Supper, recalling Jesus’ final meal with His disciples (Luke 22:14–20), and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, traditionally associated with Peter’s denial of Jesus (Luke 22:54–62).

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner | **Overnight:** Jerusalem

Days 9 - 11 Tour ITINERARY

DAY 9 | SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2027 | Old City Jerusalem Via Dolorosa • Garden Tomb • Tower of David Sound and Light Show

Walk through Jerusalem's Old City along the Via Dolorosa, remembering the final hours before the crucifixion of Jesus (John 19:16–17). Visit St. Anne's Church and the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed a man who had been unable to walk for many years (John 5:1–9), and continue to the traditional site of the Judgment Hall of Pilate (John 18:28–19:16). One of the most meaningful moments of our journey will be our visit to the Garden Tomb, where we will have time for communion, worship, and reflection on the death and resurrection of Jesus (Matthew 27:57–60; Matthew 28:1–10). In the evening, enjoy the spectacular Sound and Light Show at the Tower of David, where Jerusalem's long history comes alive through images, music, and light projected against the ancient walls.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner | Overnight: Jerusalem

DAY 10 | SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2027 | City of David, Western Wall Tunnels and Israel Museum

Begin the day exploring the City of David, the ancient core of Jerusalem captured by King David and established as his capital (2 Samuel 5:6–10). Explore the Pilgrimage Road, associated with the route taken by Jewish pilgrims ascending toward the Temple during the Second Temple period and bringing to life the Jerusalem experienced during the time of Jesus (Psalm 122:1–4; Luke 2:41–46). Continue through the Western Wall Tunnels, where we will explore remarkable remains connected to the massive retaining walls surrounding the Temple Mount built during the Second Temple period. At the Israel Museum, visit the Shrine of the Book, home to several of the Dead Sea Scrolls, and see the impressive model of Jerusalem as it appeared around the time of Jesus. The model provides a wonderful visual perspective on many of the places described in the Gospels.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner | Overnight: Jerusalem

DAY 11 | MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2027 | Free Morning, Ein Karem, Valley of Elah, Farewell Dinner and Departure

Enjoy a free morning in Jerusalem for last-minute shopping, relaxation, or personal exploration. Meet at the hotel at 12:00 noon and depart for Ein Karem, traditionally associated with the birthplace of John the Baptist and the meeting of Mary and Elizabeth (Luke 1:39–45; Luke 1:57–66). Continue to the Valley of Elah, where David faced Goliath (1 Samuel 17:1–51), and visit Tel Azekah for a beautiful view overlooking the biblical battlefield. Time permitting, we may also visit Khirbet Qeiyafa, an archaeological site associated with the period of King David. In the evening, enjoy a special farewell dinner at a local restaurant before transferring to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight home.

Meals: Breakfast and Dinner | Overnight: On Board

PLEASE NOTE:

*Since flights are not yet available for booking, we are arranging the tour program with the hope of securing a Monday night departure from Tel Aviv. This would allow us to enjoy a full day of touring on Monday before transferring to the airport. Our preferred option is to fly on Monday night; however, many airlines depart from Tel Aviv earlier in the day. If our best available flight departs on Monday morning, the itinerary will be adjusted accordingly.

*Remember to bring your Bible and notepad as we study the Scriptures at each site identified in the Bible.

- **Credit-Card Payments:** A 4% credit card handling fee applies to the final payment when paid by credit card. The \$500 tour deposit is not subject to a credit card handling fee. All amounts paid by card over and above \$500 per person are subject to 4% credit card fees.

Flight Departure Information

Since flights are not yet available for booking, there are two possible departure options. Our preferred option is a Monday evening/overnight flight; however, many airlines depart Tel Aviv earlier in the day. The final schedule will depend on the best available airfare and flight options.

Monday Morning Flight—September 13, 2027

Following Sunday's sightseeing, we will return to the hotel for a farewell dinner and overnight stay. On Monday morning, we will transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight home. If we use this option, the itinerary will be adjusted accordingly so that the planned sightseeing is still included.

Monday Evening/Overnight Flight—September 13, 2027

After our touring day, we will enjoy our farewell dinner at a local restaurant before transferring to Ben Gurion Airport for our flight home. Arrival in the U.S. will be on Tuesday morning, September 14, 2027.
