DAY 1 | SUNDAY, OCTOBER 24, 2027

DEPART THE UNITED STATES

Our unforgettable journey begins as we depart the United States for Egypt. Over the next two weeks, we will follow in the footsteps of Moses, the prophets, Jesus, and the apostles as we journey through Egypt, Jordan, and Israel, bringing the Bible to life.

DAY 2 | MONDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2027

WELCOME TO EGYPT

Upon arrival in Cairo, meet our local representative and transfer to your hotel near the Great Pyramids of Giza. Egypt played an important role throughout Scripture as the land of Abraham, Joseph, and Moses. Enjoy dinner and rest before tomorrow's sightseeing.

DAY 3 | TUESDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2027

PYRAMIDS OF GIZA • SPHINX • CAMEL RIDE • GRAND EGYPTIAN MUSEUM

Today we explore the Great Pyramids of Giza, enter the Great Pyramid of Khufu, visit the Sphinx, and enjoy a camel ride. Later, we tour the Grand Egyptian Museum, including treasures from Tutankhamun's reign. Reflecting on Joseph and God's preservation of Israel during famine (Genesis 41–47), we see Egypt's important place in the biblical story. Return to the hotel for dinner.

DAY 4 | WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 27, 2027

LAND OF GOSHEN • TANIS (SAN EL-HAGAR) • NILE DELTA

After breakfast, we travel through the Nile Delta to San El-Hagar, ancient Tanis, believed by many scholars to be biblical Zoan and part of the land of Goshen, where the Israelites lived before the Exodus (Psalm 78:12, 43). Explore the ruins of this ancient capital, including statues, temples, obelisks, and royal tombs, and gain a deeper understanding of the world of Moses and the Exodus. After lunch, we return to Cairo for dinner. Scripture References: Psalm 78:12, 43 • Exodus 1:11

DAY 5 | THURSDAY, OCTOBER 28, 2027

THE SINAI PENINSULA • THE EXODUS ROUTE

After breakfast, we leave Cairo and travel across the Suez Canal into the Sinai Peninsula, tracing the traditional Exodus route. As we journey through the wilderness toward Mount Sinai, we reflect on God's deliverance of Israel from slavery and His provision during the forty years in the desert. This evening, enjoy a traditional Bedouin dinner and overnight near the mountain where many believe Moses received the Ten Commandments.

DAY 6 | FRIDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2027

ST. CATHERINE'S MONASTERY • NUEIBA • TABA • AQABA

After breakfast, we visit historic St. Catherine's Monastery at the foot of Mount Sinai, one of the world's oldest continuously operating Christian monasteries. We then travel through the Sinai Peninsula to Nuweiba on the Gulf of Aqaba, a region many scholars associate with the Israelites' crossing of the Red Sea (Exodus 14). Continuing to Taba, we ferry across the Red Sea to Jordan, where we meet our Jordanian guide and transfer to our Red Sea resort in Aqaba for dinner and overnight. Scripture Reference: Exodus 14:13–31

DAY 7 | SATURDAY, OCTOBER 30, 2027 PETRA • DEAD SEA

Today we visit Petra, one of the world's greatest archaeological treasures. Walking through the narrow Siq, we emerge before the breathtaking Treasury before exploring the city's tombs, temples, and ancient streets carved into rose-colored rock. Following our visit, we travel north to the Dead Sea for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8 | SUNDAY, OCTOBER 31, 2027 MADABA • MOUNT NEBO • CROSSING INTO ISRAEL • JAFFA

This morning we visit Madaba, home to the famous Byzantine mosaic map of the Holy Land, followed by Mount Nebo, where Moses viewed the Promised Land before his death (Deuteronomy 34). Crossing into Israel via the Allenby Bridge, we meet our Israeli guide and continue to Old Jaffa, where Peter received his vision concerning the Gentiles and Tabitha was raised from the dead (Acts 9–10).

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner | **Overnight:** Tel Aviv, Israel

DAY 9 | MONDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 2027 CAESAREA • MOUNT CARMEL • MEGIDDO • NAZARETH • SEA OF GALILEE

Our day begins at Caesarea Maritima, where Peter shared the Gospel with Cornelius, the first Gentile convert (Acts 10). We continue to Mount Carmel, where Elijah challenged the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18), and Megiddo, overlooking the Valley of Armageddon (Revelation 16:16). In Nazareth, we visit the Church of the Annunciation (Luke 1:26–38), pass through Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle (John 2:1–11), and arrive at the Sea of Galilee.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner | **Overnight:** Sea of Galilee, Israel

DAY 10 | TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 2, 2027 TEL DAN • CAESAREA PHILIPPI • MOUNT OF BEATITUDES • TABGHA • CAPERNAUM

After breakfast, we travel to Tel Dan, home to the famous Tel Dan Stele, the earliest archaeological reference to the House of David. Nearby, we visit Caesarea Philippi, where Peter declared Jesus to be the Christ (Matthew 16:13–18). Returning to the Sea of Galilee, we visit the Mount of Beatitudes, Tabgha and the Church of the Multiplication (Matthew 14:13–21), and Capernaum, where Jesus taught, healed, and performed many miracles. We visit the ancient synagogue and the traditional site of Peter's home before returning to our hotel for dinner.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner | **Overnight:** Sea of Galilee, Israel

DAY 11 | WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 3, 2027 SEA OF GALILEE BOAT RIDE • ANCIENT JESUS BOAT • MAGDALA • JORDAN RIVER • BETH SHEAN • DEAD SEA

This morning we enjoy a memorable boat ride on the Sea of Galilee and visit the 2,000-year-old Ancient Jesus Boat. We continue to Magdala, hometown of Mary Magdalene, before visiting Yardenit on the Jordan River, where those who wish may participate in a baptismal service (Matthew 3:13–17). Traveling through the Jordan Valley, we explore Beth Shean, where the bodies of Saul and his sons were displayed (1 Samuel 31), before arriving at the Dead Sea to enjoy its mineral-rich waters and resort facilities.

DAY 12 | THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2027

MASADA • EIN GEDI • QUMRAN • BETHLEHEM • JERUSALEM

After breakfast, we ascend Masada by cable car and explore Herod's desert fortress overlooking the Dead Sea. We then enjoy views of Ein Gedi, where David sought refuge from King Saul (1 Samuel 24), before visiting Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Continuing to Jerusalem, the City of Zion, we visit Bethlehem, Manger Square, Bethlehem Nativity Souvenirs, and Shepherds' Field, where the angels announced Christ's birth. Arrive at our Jerusalem hotel.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner | **Overnight:** Jerusalem, Israel

DAY 13 | FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2027

MOUNT OF OLIVES • GETHSEMANE • WESTERN WALL • JEWISH QUARTER • TEMPLE INSTITUTE • MOUNT ZION

Today we begin with panoramic views of Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives, where Jesus wept over the city and later ascended into heaven (Luke 19:41; Acts 1:9–12). Walking the Palm Sunday Road, we visit the Garden of Gethsemane (Matthew 26:36–46), the Southern Temple Mount excavations, and the Davidson Center. We continue to the Western Wall, the Jewish Quarter, and the Temple Institute before experiencing the unique atmosphere of Jerusalem preparing for Shabbat. Our day concludes on Mount Zion with visits to the Upper Room and St. Peter in Gallicantu.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner | **Overnight:** Jerusalem, Israel

DAY 14 | SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2027 | OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM • VIA DOLOROSA • ST. ANNE'S CHURCH • POOL OF BETHESDA • HOLY SEPULCHRE • OLD CITY BAZAARS • GARDEN TOMB

Today we walk through the heart of biblical Jerusalem. Entering through Lion's Gate, we visit St. Anne's Church and the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus healed the paralytic (John 5:1–9). We then follow the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher (Luke 23:33–53). Enjoy free time in the colorful Old City bazaars before concluding the day at the Garden Tomb with a special communion service celebrating Christ's resurrection (Matthew 28:1–10). Return to our hotel for dinner.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner | **Overnight:** Jerusalem, Israel

DAY 15 | SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2027 | FREE TIME • CITY OF DAVID • PILGRIMAGE ROAD • WESTERN WALL TUNNELS • ISRAEL MUSEUM • FAREWELL DINNER • DEPARTURE (or extra night if needed)

Enjoy a relaxed morning in Jerusalem before meeting at the hotel for our final sightseeing. We visit the City of David and walk along the ancient Pilgrimage Road to the Temple Mount. We then explore the Western Wall Tunnels and the Israel Museum, home to the Shrine of the Book and the Dead Sea Scrolls. For Sunday evening departures, we enjoy a farewell dinner before transferring to Ben Gurion Airport. For Monday departures, we return to the hotel after sightseeing, enjoy a farewell dinner, and transfer to the airport the following morning.

Meals: Breakfast & Dinner | **Overnight:** Jerusalem, Israel (Extra night if needed will be added to the tour cost)

DAY 16 | MONDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2027 ARRIVE BACK IN THE UNITED STATES

Today we arrive home after an extraordinary journey through Egypt, Jordan, and Israel. Having walked where Moses led, where prophets proclaimed God's Word, and where Jesus lived, taught, died, and rose again, we return with a renewed appreciation for the Bible and the lands that bring its pages to life.
